



Walk 15 Burton Joyce **Heritage Trail**

Length - 1½ miles (2 km). Allow 1 hour.

Terrain - Easy walking on pavements. Not suitable for wheelchairs due to an awkward railway crossing.

See details of the walk on the Board at the Old School in the village centre.

The oldest pub in the village is probably **The Lord Nelson**. There would have been an inn here for centuries to cater for the men hauling boats up the river, and later for their horses.

The present **Wheatsheaf** dates from the 1930's when Church Road was built. There was an earlier Wheatsheaf next door to the **Cross Keys**.

The Local History Society has also produced a more detailed History Trail around Burton Joyce and Bulcote. Copies of this can be purchased from the Carnarvon Room, which is open on Tuesday mornings, or from the village Library.
